HISTORY BOY was never far back, rallied in the far turn for the final time, vied for the lead jumping the last, dueled to the wire and drew off in the final strides. MISCHIEF was on the pace got to the lead on the backstretch the last time around, was headed jumping the last, dueled and gave way in the final strides. PRIMERO PERU dropped back after a mile and passed faders in the last stages of the race. SERGEANT KARAKORUM stalked the leader, but was out run from the second last jump home. EMBARRASSED was in contention, then tired badly on the final turn. TRIBAL SHELTER was far back and stayed there. JOT'S JIB took command for a mile and a half, then stopped and was pulled up before the last jump. COLONIAL KID trailed and pulled up after the eighth jump.
