BARNSTORMING was allowed to settle in back of the field, closed with a rush three wide on the final turn, dueled with FARNDALE and TWISTER CROSSING jumping the last and drew off going to the wire. TWISTER CROSSING stalked pace, was right there jumping the last, dueled with FARNDALE and just up for second. FARNDALE was caught going to the final jump, dueled and just missed for second at the wire. SHARPS ISLAND was never a factor. THE EDITOR was through after a mile.
