PAC N IRON dueled for lead between rivals from outset, gained nod into stretch, lost advantage mid stretch, responded to strong handling and came again to prove best in late going. JACKS BIGWHEEL dueled outside rivals from start, responded to gain advantage mid stretch, went gamely to wire but was not good enough. THIRTY ONE JONES within striking distance along inside from start, lacked needed late response in drive. X STREME off slowly, regrouped, came eight wide into stretch with a belated rally. JUNIOR G MAN raced in middle of pack while inside, had no rally. IN DUTCH dueled along rail to stretch, weakened. FIRST STAR DEPUTY raced outside rivals and was not a factor. DEVON ICE showed little. OLD SUEDE dueled between rivals for half, gave way. NASTY ROSE was not a threat. COWBOY HURRICANE saved ground and always outrun. MR. GLADIATOR dueled with early pace, faded steadily thereafter .
