SIBER SONG stalked the early leader from between rivals, placed a bid nearing the quarter pole to gain command into the stretch and held a safe advantage. PARIS PROSPECT broke slow at the start, then loomed boldly circling the field, moved into contention mid stretch and flattened out in the final yards. POSH EXCESS was unhurried early, went four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. MY LADY CORWYN chased the early leader saving ground and weakened in the drive. NIKESO was off slow early, raced wide and improved her position in the stretch. CALDONIAS GHOST was void of early speed and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. LEIGH WELLS was close in the early going racing from the outside then faded. COUNT GOLD set the early pace drawing clear, was hard used and stopped.
