GIMME A CLUE prompted the early pace, gained command near the quarter pole, and held well to prevail. WALL STREET RALLY was void of early speed while saving ground, angled out nearing the quarter pole, sustained a bid while splitting foes through the stretch in a game effort. ONE FOXY LADY was off slow early, angled out five wide at the quarter pole and finished with a good late effort. RUBIN'S GIRL was gaining late outside. IZ A HASTY BELLE forced the early pace four wide and flattened out in the stretch. STONECREEK pressed the early pace, tired and faded. DEPOSIT THE CASH raced wide and was no factor. APPEALINGLY BOLD failed to threaten. BEVERLYS GOLD raced in the second flight and gave way. GRAZIE PAPA led the first quarter and stopped.
