YET ANOTHERNATALIE pressed the early pace from the inside, gained a short advantage near the half, was challenged at the quarter fought gamely, then gave way grudgingly. G. STARR chased the early leaders, went three wide into the stretch, finished willingly but was no match for top two. WOMAN ONFASTTRACK stumbled badly at the break, then was slow in the early going, went four wide in the stretch and was gaining late. ORIANA'S MAGIC attended the early pace, placed a brief bid then weakened. HUMBLE ROANNIE was unhurried early and lacked a late response. SABRINA SLEW was forwardly placed early then faded steadily. DAD SMOKED CIGAR saved ground early, was wide in the stretch and was not a factor. MISS HESTER showed little in a dull effort. RUNAWAYFUN failed to threaten. SIDEWAYS failed to menace.
