TOO MUCH TIME was allowed to settle early, vied in the turn while circling the field, responded well, drew off and was much the best. X PRESS PASS was well placed early, sustained a bid near the three eighths pole but was no match late. LACY LOU prompted the early pace, rallied near the half, gained command and weakened. TILTING STAR was unhurried early and sustained a mild late rally. KIERINS KUTE KID was void of early speed and placed a mild late bid. LUCY FROM AFAR failed to threaten. SOARING DUCHESS led the first call, tired and faded. DOTS QUESTION was outrun and was not a factor. DIAMOND BELLE was forwardly placed early, faded and was eased to wire, walked off.
