NICK MISSED was unhurried early, moved up then angled out two wide at the quarter pole to place his bid and inched away in the final strides to prevail. IZA RIGHTEOUS DUDE prompted the early pace, vied nearing the three eighths pole to gain the advantage into the stretch, was caught in deep stretch and outfinished. RARE AN WINDY led the first call racing three wide, weakened then passed tired foe late. IN THE GAME pressed the early pace, drifted out in the stretch and was finished early. READY 'N GONE saved ground early and lacked a late response. BIONIC LAD trailed the field racing off the rail and was always outrun.
