### Footnotes

HEARING VOICES broke out at the start, set the pace, resisted when challenged in the stretch, drifted out late but held safe. RUNNING SQUALL lodged his bid on the turn, was four wide into the stretch, but wasn't good enough. DEITY stayed inside to lodge his bid at mid stretch then hung some late. CRUSHER LANE chased the leader but didn't have enough late. PACHE'S PRIDE was three wide on the turn but didn't have enough in the drive. A GHOST BY CHOICE was through early and never entered contention.
