WHIRL pressed the pace, took the lead around the final turn, pulled away down the stretch and won handily. LORENZON broke in the air at the break, gained ground and was a clear second. JEFFRIES BAY unhurried in the beginning, made a late bid and got up for third. MIGHT BE HOOKED raced near the back in the early part, made a steady gain, but was no factor. LOOPY LOUIE raced near the back in the early going, improved position and finished wide. TOUGH PILGRIM pressed the early pace, saved ground and weakened. BIG SWED raced in the middle of the field, made a mild bid, then faded. SLOAT BLVD raced within contention in the beginning and faded. ARCHIE'S DREAM always raced near the back and showed little. DISTINCT PROSPECT went to the front, drove clear, saved ground around the turn and dropped back. TOPPER POWER .
