Footnotes

SUETOSUETOSUE circled the leaders on the turn, lodged her bid at the top of the stretch and drove clear late. MOTHER'S SAUCE lodged a three-wide bid into the turn, was still clear at the top of the stretch then couldn't contain the winner. SHOULD settled some after the start, was four wide into the stretch then finished willingly late. WEDNESDAYAFTERNOON was with the pace along the rail down the backstretch, stayed in contention to the drive then weakened late. BETTER RAIN was three wide to the turn, loomed a threat to the top of the stretch then lacked a further bid. FUNKY CHANTEAL settled some early, was angled eight wide for the drive and didn't threaten. BANANA CREAM PIE raced along the rail then stayed inside for the drive and didn't threaten. MOTEL CHAIN forced the early pace but was through after three furlong and tired in the drive. UNUSUALLY BRITE never threatened and was not a factor. SLEWFULS STAR broke awkwardly and lost the rider shortly after the start.
