TOO LOW FOR ZERO made the lead, then drew off at the quarter pole and was the easy winner. MR COZZDOE forced the pace going three wide, made a bid and got up for place. SMEDLEY stalked the pace on the inside, angled out the quarter pole and rallied down the lane. SUNLAND SOUVENIR broke slow and trailed the field early, then angled out in the stretch and closed well. WHATSFOREVERFOR was mid field on the inside with an even effort. PATRICK YULLA pressed the pace going two wide and faded. YER HUCKLEBERRY got off slow on the inside and had no rally. SUNKA CAT broke slow, then made a mild early bid but had no late run.
