SUREFIRE SUCCESS stalked the pace, then offered a mild bid, three wide, to get up for show. ARCHIE'S DREAM vied for the lead, along the inside, but faded at the five sixteenths pole. BARTOKS BRAVEHEART had no early foot, on the rail and drifted out down the lane, six wide. GONE TILL MIDNIGHT was near the back, on the rail, showing mild late effort.
