DANZIG TERA forced the pace, going three to four wide, offered a bid and got up late for the win. CARDENALA made the lead, but gave way at the sixteenth pole to hold on for second. RINGER BELL was mid pack, along the inside, then rallied between horses and got up for show. DEVON'S BEBE got off slow, and closed, going four to five wide. RIO DE LANEY RAE was near the back, showing mild late interest, going four wide. SHES YOUR RIDER was in the middle of the pack, two wide, with an even effort. SUNDAY BONNET was mid field, offered a bid on the turn, but flattened out down the lane. CMON PATSY had no speed, five wide and no bid. FINANCIAL BAILOUT had no early foot and no late run. CHAMA GIRL pressed the pace, on the inside, but retreated early.
