DEL MAR DRAMA was in the middle of the pack, then closed, going four wide to get up late for the win. HANK ACE pressed the pace, then made the lead at the three eighths pole, but faltered down the lane. WESTERN ACT set the early pace, giving way at the three eighths pole, and held on for third. OUR BIG SQUEEZE had no early foot and offered a mild rally, three to four wide. FOLLOW THE WIND was in contention early, three wide and lacked a late response. THATS MR. TO YOU trailed the field, two wide, offered a mild bid, but hung late. CRIMSON STAR was mid pack, on the inside and faded in the stretch. WE GOT DA FEVA had no early, speed, going wide throughout, with no bid. MIKEY'STEXASHOLDEM was mid field, two to three wide and retreated.
