NORDIC WIND took the lead into the turn, set the pace and held sway under right-handed urging. SEISMOMETER set the early pace then chased the winner and failed to gain in the late stages. LEESTOWNS FINALE was three wide on the turn and four wide into the stretch then had no late bid. STONEWALL RIOT was bothered some into the turn, was six wide into the stretch and lacked a late bid. ULTIMINIO R. saved ground on the turn, stayed inside and lacked a solid late bid. PIRATE'S JOURNEY broke alertly, was six wide on the turn then lacked a stretch rally. DUNN SLINGER broke with the field then flashed brief speed and tired in the stretch. SUNLAND SOUVENIR was a bit fractious at the gate then broke slowly and trailed throughout.
