UTARON was mid pack on the inside, then made a bid between horses and drew off from the field. LADY ICON was in the middle of the pack, then rallied, four wide and got up for place. TRIBE OF JUDAH trailed the field early, angled out at the quarter pole and closed going five wide. COWBOY'S KITTY forced the pace, two wide, then dueled for the lead through the turn but gave way at the quarter pole. OPERA SINGER got shuffled back early and rallied up the rail. CAROLYN ABBEY made the lead, but faltered at the eighth pole. ARE YOU CRAZY was mid field, three wide then dropped back. LAZER RUN pressed the pace, drifted wide into the stretch and faded at the quarter pole. IN EXCESSIVE FLICK was mid pack on the inside and lacked the needed late response. LADY FOCUS had no early foot and retreated.
