**Footnotes**

PAVLICHENKO unhurried in the early part, moved up four wide around the turn, made a bid down the stretch, racing four wide and was just up. HIGH POCKETS went to the front, drove clear, saved ground around the turn and was caught at the wire. ANGEL OF THE WIND pressed the pace, saved ground around the turn and was outfinished for second. CHAMPAGNEONSUNDAY was an early factor, forwardly placed throughout and lacked a late kick. SANTI'S GIRL pressed the early pace and weakened. JUST A GLIMPSE raced near the back, showed late interest, but was no factor. CLASSY BREEZE raced within contention, came around the turn four wide and faded. ISAY A LADY raced in the middle of the field and was never a factor. SKI TICKET raced evenly near the back and lacked a bid. RANANDI void of early speed, came around the turn seven wide and was never a threat. SHREWD CAT always raced near the back and showed little. BABY GLITTER broke slow, ducked in and was never a threat.
