PRINCE CARSON vied for the early lead, drove clear and finished well. WHISKEY LULLABY pressed the pace, moved up on the outside around the turn, proved no match for the winner, but was best of others. DOGIE raced near the back, came around the turn four wide, made a late bid, proved no match for the top two, but got up for third. CELEBRATE FREEDOM lacked early speed, showed late interest, but was no factor. SOARING IN EXCESS raced within contention and faded. SIGN OF THE FOUR pressed the pace, raced inside around the turn, waited, blocked, faded at the head of the stretch and was eased. INDIGO POWER always raced near the back and was outrun.
