SIMPLE DEAL set the pace, then drew off while drifting, six wide, to win with a driving finish. BEER THIRTY TIME was mid field, angled out at the quarter pole, six wide, offered a bid and got up for second. UPTOWN EGO was mid pack, two wide, then rallied down the lane to get up for show. ULTIMINIO R. was in contention early, four wide, offered a bid on the turn, but flattened out in the stretch drive. HEARING VOICES was forwardly placed, three wide, then got in tight and was squeezed back at the sixteenth pole. JARETT'S CAT stalked the pace, two wide, angled out at the quarter pole, offered a bid but faltered late. SARATOGA POP A TOP was near the back, on the rail, with mild late interest. CHOPINS NOTE pressed the pace, on the inside and faded in the turn. SMOKIN AVENUE showed no early foot, on the rail and never fired. SUNKA CAT fell at the sixteenth pole and was vanned off.
