ELUSIVE JAZZ TIME broke out some at the start, lodged his bid to the lead near the stretch and drew clear in the drive. MATCHSTICK MAN was just off the early leaders, closed well late while drifting out some. ZEE BEST HENNYSEE settled some after the start, was four wide into the stretch and finished well. PACHE OF GOLD set the pace, resisted some into the stretch and weakened. TONY THE CAT was three wide on the turn then went evenly and lacked any stretch bid. STARRING CHAYO was six wide on the turn and four wide into the stretch then lacked a solid bid. RIVER JONES broke alertly then settled some into the turn and tired in the stretch. PACHE'S PRIDE was slow into stride and five wide on the turn but was through early.
