PAKEA BAY never far back, bid outside stretch, up in time. THE REAL RABBIT set pace, clear in stretch, came in into turn. AFFLUENT BOY broke alertly, chased top pair to stretch, rallied late. KC ROYAL FLUSH broke with field, gradually advanced, some late gain. I KNOW BEDARINA broke with field, evenly, lacked stretch bid. DITTIN KNOW broke alertly, had position early, weakened late. SOUTH OAK broke alertly, bothered into turn, fell back, never recovered. FAMOUS LORD SHEZADI broke near back, evenly, never seriously threatened.
