Footnotes

SAGAPONACK was mid field, three wide and closed between horses for a driving finish. OUR BIG SQUEEZE was in the middle of the pack, rallied two wide and just missed. YIELD A WINNER pressed the pace on the inside, gained command in the stretch and faltered late. PATHBREAKING was near the back and made a steady gain three to four wide. SANDY BOB made the lead and gave way in the stretch. KICK ROCKS was mid pack going four wide, made a bid on the turn but hung in the lane. STRANGER chased the pace, two wide but lacked the needed late response. FREDDY CAT stalked the pace, two wide and retreated at the three eighths pole. HIGH BLUFF had no speed with a wide trip and passed tiring rivals. YELLOWSTONE (HUN) forced the pace on the rail but faded at the quarter pole. TEN DEUCE had no early foot and never fired. ARCHIE'S DREAM was forwardly place early with a rail trip but faded at the three eighths pole.
