GAMBLER BILL lodged his bid on the turn, took charge then came in some in deep stretch and was disqualified for interference and placed second. THE HUNT IS ON was bumped in tight quarters into the turn, was bothered in deep stretch and was placed first by disqualification. DESERT LIGHTNING was just off the early leaders, took a short lead into the turn then weakened in the stretch. SNEAK AND PEAK saved ground on the turn then went evenly and lacked a solid stretch bid. A. J. DA SKIPPER forced the early pace then was seven wide into the stretch and weakened. AIRWAR was three wide into the turn then eight wide into the stretch and tired. ZARB'S HOT FRIEND was fractious in the paddock before entering the track, was four wide to the turn and five wide into the stretch. IRISH MONARCH was five wide to the turn and four wide into the stretch and didn't threaten. TEHUANTEPECER dropped far back and trailed throughout and found his best way too late.
