ANGEL PEAK set the pace and went wire to wire to be the easy winner. YULIA was in the middle of the pack, going four wide, then closed in the stretch drive to be second best. FRANNIE GO GO broke sharp and was taken back, then offered a mild bid, five wide, and got up for show. DESERT FLAG was in contention early, then rallied up the rail and dead heated for fourth. RINGER BELL forced the pace, three wide and offered a mild bid to dead heat for fourth. I B QUICK was near the back, four wide and showed mild late interest. YVETITA had no early foot, with a mild late rally up the rail. DUSTY DIAMONDS pressed the pace, two wide, but stopped in the turn. AMERICAN LASS showed early speed, five wide, but faded at the quarter pole. RUN ABBY RUN was mid field, along the inside, shied from a foe and jumped at the three eighths then retreated. PERFUME AND ROUGE was mid pack, three wide and was through at the half.
