**Footnotes**

BRAHMS INFERNO was never far back inside, angled out on the turn, inched clear in the upper stretch and held. SPEED KING was slow early, rallied around the turn, closed well but didn't have enough late. STRIKE A SPIDER pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, weakened in the drive but held safely for show. EVANSVILLE VAN stalked outside, fell back on the turn and faded through the stretch. ONE TOUGH HOMBRE set a pressured pace to the turn, weakened and faded through the stretch. ROBYNS RETURN showed speed to the turn and gave way. STAFFHOUSE ROAD was not a factor.
