Footnotes

OTILIO had no speed, but closed willingly between horses, going two wide, and got up at the wire. IRISH TITO was near the front, then had a strong late surge, going five wide, to grab place. WEST OF TEXAS set the pace, opening up, then drifted, four wide in the stretch, and was outfinished. YVETT'S MAAR was in contention early, four wide, offered a bid on the turn, but hung late. THREEGOODKIDS pressed the pace early from the rail, but faded at the quarter pole. SUAVEY forced the pace early, two wide, but gave way at the five sixteenths. TRAVELIN JONES was near the back, along the rail, angled out on the turn, but lacked a late response. BANDONTHELOOSE had no early foot, on the rail, but offered a mild rally down the lane.
