RIG'S RUNNER vied for the early lead, forwardly placed throughout and drove clear late. SAPELLO SHOOTER raced within striking distance, made a bid, proved no match for the winner, but held on for second. SEEKING A MINT raced near the back in the early part, made a steady gain and finished willingly. ZIG BULLS WAY brushed at the start, pressed the pace, came around the turn three wide and faded. MY PICASSO broke out, vied for the early lead, came around the turn three wide and faded. PAL O DOME raced in the back of the pack, improved position, but was no factor. IN FLAGS HONOR dueled for the early lead and retreated. HONOR EXPRESS raced in the middle of the field, had a wide trip, dropped back and was eased. BERNARDO STAR always raced near the back and was eased.
