KELA DAWN saved ground, angled out on the second turn, challenged three across into the stretch, dueled through the lane, ducked out near the wire and held while fully extended. FIRST CLASSNTHESKY was unhurried early, angled out in the upper stretch, closed willingly, was gaining fast late and was crowded near the wire. END OF DISCUSSION vied inside throughout, had little left late and was caught for place. RON'S ALIBI raced mid pack, bid inside leaving the turn, angled out near the eighth pole and didn't have enough late. RIO DIABLO was never far off the pace but lacked the needed late response. DOUBLEINADIRTYGLAS veered out at the start, vied two across to the stretch, tired and gave way. MAGICAL SATURDAY failed to threaten in an even effort. The trainer of FIRST CLASSNTHESKY lodged an objection for alleged interference near the wire. No change was made. PER NEW MEXICO RACING COMMISSION RULING NO. 3096812, DATED 10/26/12, KELA DAWN WAS DISQUALIFIED FOR INTERFERENCE TO FIRST CLASSNTHESKY NEARING THE FINISH LINE AND PLACED SECOND.
