BYE BYE BUBBA pressed the pace, raced outside around the turn and pulled away down the stretch. PALTU went to the front, led until late, couldn't match strides with the winner, but was best of others. STRIKINOUT N MIAMI raced near the back in the beginning, made a steady gain, finished wide and got up for third. CRAFTY BRENT vied for the early lead, saved ground around the turn and weakened. COLORADO GRAY raced in the middle of the field, came around the turn three wide, made a bid and weakened. CLASSY LOVER raced near the back and was never close. ARCHIE'S DREAM broke poorly and was never a threat. SIX PICKER PAUL pressed the early pace, drifted out around the turn and dropped back.
