Footnotes

COUNTRYBUMPKIN WHO was soon clear, stayed off the inside through the turn, put to steady urging the last eighth and gradually lengthened command. WISHNDONTMAKEITSO in midpack early, moved to the inside on the turn, was all out in the lane and moved clear for second inside the last eighth. K D RANSOM without early foot between horses, was three wide on the turn, swung out widest for the stretch run and caught J J MASQUERADE for third in the waning yards. J J MASQUERADE chased COUNTRYBUMPKIN WHO first from inside then outside that one, was challenged for second from inside on the turn, floated out to path four into the lane and tried to drift out while wearing down inside the final furlong. DOMS TOP CAT also void of speed between rivals, was two wide on the bend, fanned out behind J J MASQUERADE entering the stretch and had no late bid. HALF VOLLEY showed no speed from inside, floated out some into the lane and was empty. CANOSO ESPIA stayed well off the inside throughout and showed little.
