GHOST VAPORS broke awkwardly, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled to late stretch, yielded but held for show. NO IT AIN'T failed to gain in a steady effort. SANTAQUIN vied inside to the turn, weakened and fell back. HAPPY TOES broke in, saved ground and lacked a bid. FOX IN THE HOUSE was not a factor.
