HILLBILLYHARLAN was mid pack, then angled in at the five sixteenths pole, and made a bid between horses and held on at the wire for the win. ACTIONABLE OFFENSE was near the back, then angled out, five to seven wide around the turn, and closed fast just missing at the wire. CHIEF GET A CLUE showed no early speed, then rallied, two wide and got up for show. OVER THE RIVER set the pace early, lugged out around the turn, six to seven wide, and gave way. FASTER THAN SMART forced the pace, three wide, getting carried out in the stretch, and faded. NATHAN'S SPECIAL had brief speed, then pressed the pace, three wide, but dropped back in the turn. BUCALYOU had no early foot, five wide, and lacked a response. OH SMOOSH was forwardly placed early, two wide, but retreated in the stretch. NACO trailed the field, three wide and showed little.
