MR. TRIESTE was off slow early, advanced steadily, splitting foes nearing the quarter, placed a bid to kick away at the eighth pole and was clear late. WESTERN RIDGE set a pressured early pace from the outside, was collared nearing the eighth pole, dug in to come again late but could not match strides with the winner. SPIRIT GULCH stalked the early leaders, lost ground into the stretch, angled out three wide to come again in deep stretch. IMDABOSSAU was unhurried early racing off the rail, vied in the stretch and closed belatedly. SHARM forced the early pace saving ground, gained a short lead nearing the quarter and came up empty in the stretch. NEVER TAP TWICE was allowed to settle early, raced five wide and weakened. XTRA ICEE raced mid pack and faded. CHARLIE'S BULLET showed little, saved ground to no avail. ONE PIT WONDER failed to threaten.
