ALAKAZAM rallied between horses along the backstretch, challenged for the lead on the turn and drew off in the drive under urging. TEANCUM swung wide entering the stretch, closed well but was no match for the winner. TAPITS WILDCAT raced mid pack, angled out mid stretch, offered a mild bid only and was along for show. ROYAL REGENT was crowded at the start and improved position in a steady effort. SECURITYSNIGHTMARE broke slowly, fell back early, raced evenly and improved position. MR. OMEARA was not a threat. DUBBER set a pressured pace to the turn and flattened out. TIZ SEXY pressed the pace outside to the turn and stopped. PULPITS ATTITUDE showed speed to the turn and gave way. JANTASTIC HOLIDAY raced close to the pace, stopped on the turn and dropped back. SUENO AZUL was not a factor. MARKET TREND pressed the pace inside, was through early and stopped.
