QUITE A LINE made the lead, then dueled in early stretch, drifting out four wide finally drawing clear for the win. BOLD PROGRAM pressed the pace, made a bid in the turn to duel with QUITE A LINE in the early stretch drive but gave way at the eighth pole. STEVE'S FANTASY was near the back, angled in and rallied up the rail to grab third. SALTY LANE was void of early foot and made a bid going three to four wide. ROMANINTHESTORM was mid field going two wide with a mild bid. ANNIE'S BOY stalked the pace, three wide and faded after the half. JOLI'S DOME trailed the field early with a wide trip and was no factor. MUSIC MANIA was in contention early on the inside and retreated at the three eighths pole.
