RUNAWAY WONDERCAT was near the back, then closed, six wide and drew off late for the win. PERKINSVILLE showed no early speed, two wide, but had a strong late surge between horses to get up for second. SOUTH BY WHO was in contention early, then offered a bid, four to five wide and got third. AGGRAVATED BATTERY vied for the lead, along the inside, then drifted three wide, in the stretch and faltered late. PERFECTLY SANE was mid pack, three wide, then dropped back around the turn, and offered a mild bid. MOUNTAIN DREAMER vied for the lead, four wide, but gave way late. COWBOY HOY stalked the pace, from the rail, made a bid, but flattened out late. FAST ZAC was forwardly placed, four to five wide, and retreated in the stretch.
