Footnotes

NEEDANOTHERFEELING was mid pack, then closed up the rail, with a driving finish to grab the win. YELLOW BIRD was mid field, getting boxed in and steadied repeatedly from the turn and was probably best. BERNARDO STAR was in the middle of the pack, and made a strong late surge, five wide to get up for show. RON'S REJECT vied for the lead early, then forced the pace, three wide, made a bid, but weakened late. PULPITS PROSPECT trailed the field, along the inside, angled out at the quarter pole and offered a mild bid. MR. VALENTINO vied for the lead early, then pressed the pace, from the inside, but gave way at the quarter pole. MR MYSTERIOUS was near the front early, four wide and retreated. HEZA ALLIGATOR set the early pace, but faded at the quarter pole. GOLD SWEEP was near the back, three wide, with no rally. MOON DEAL showed no speed and was eased in the stretch.
