TW DASHBOARDLIGHTS prominent between horses, found himself boxed in behind the pacesetter nearing the turn, waited for room just off the inside on the turn, angled out three wide upper stretch, rallied under steady urging and got up in time. GALLOPING BAYOU soon gained a narrow lead between rivals, was headed from inside on the turn, came again while two wide in the lane, regained a slight lead, fought gamely but was outfinished. GOLDEN CHANCE well placed inside, gained the lead on the turn, battled through the stretch, did not have enough in the waning yards but proved easily best of the rest. SUMSUMSUMMERTIME bobbled a bit at the break then was steadied behind traffic, was soon outside, stayed in path four taking the turn, angled in some midstretch and gradually lugged in as he advanced in the late going. SHE'S COOL AS ICE pressed from outside, was also four wide through the bend then flattened out for the drive. HERE COMES DOME displayed early speed between horses but faded three wide on the turn. MISS LAKEVIEW without speed from inside, floated out some on the turn, angled out widest upper stretch and had little to offer.
