COME IN ALMIGHTY was mid pack, two wide, then closed up the rail and drew off late for the win. WIND ON WATER took a brief lead, then dropped back to chase the pace, offered a bid and held on for second. TW DASHBOARDLIGHTS was mid field, made a bid, but got boxed in down the stretch and got up for show late. DOC FITCH broke sharp and opened up from the five sixteenths pole, but gave way late. MR. TRAV was in contention early, four wide, offered a bid, but flattened out down the lane. EXPRESSED was near the back, on the inside and lacked a late response. WEST TEXAS EXPRESS showed no early foot, four wide, with no late run. OZILDA'S GLITTER pressed the pace, two wide and faded in the stretch. OPERA JIM had no early speed, going four to five wide and was through early.
