STAR VALE was mid field, then closed, four wide, and drew off from the field in late stretch for the win. PINKY'S BOOTS stalked the pace, along the rail, offered a bid and got up for place. SWISS JEWEL vied for the lead, two wide, but gave way at the eighth pole. POP MY CORK broke sharp and was taken back, then made a mild bid, five wide. CHAMA GIRL was near the back, two wide, with a mild rally. ONLY GRACE vied for the lead through the turn, but faded at the quarter pole. BARBS CHICK had no early speed, four wide, and lacked a late response. HEART BREAK HANNAH was mid pack, on the inside, going four wide and retreated. FROST FREE was in the middle of the pack, made a bid on the turn, from the inside, but was pulled up and vanned off in the stretch.
