SPINNING TOUCH a step slow at the break, was settled for a half mile, picked up his pace going to the second turn, swung around traffic leaving that bend, weaved between rivals in the lane while all out, closed from inside nd caught TRAIN RIDER BLUES in the final strides. TRAIN RIDER BLUES rated from inside, went for the lead two wide on the second turn, fanned out further entering the stretch, moved clear, battled the last eighth but was outfinished in a game try. CHIEF LAZ broke alertly, was quickly clear, showed the way in hand, was challenged from outside leaving the second turn, floated out some entering the stretch and gradually wore down. GO BARNEY GO rated from outside on the backstretch, made his move three wide on the second turn but hung in the lane. JADED DREAMS was a brief contender but faded along the rail on the second bend. GET UP TAYLOR was prominent while also in hand just outside the early speed but gave way leaving the second turn.
