HONSHU CITY bumped at the start, raced close to the pace inside, awaited room on the turn, eased out for the drive, bid, dueled and proved best. BOY EGO raced close to the pace outside, bid willingly, dueled in late stretch, was outfinished but earned second. RUSSIANONTHERAIL moved up to challenge three across on the turn, inched away for a short lead, dueled late and was outclosed. SIX MILLION was slow early while racing outside, closed well but didn't have enough late. OAK BARREL was never far back outside, bid and hung. VALET M G broke out and bumped at the start, raced in the back and offered a mild bid only. SILENT PURPOSE vied to mid stretch and faltered. DOCTOR SPENCER improved position in an even effort. ZENON'S STAR was slow early, bid inside leaving the turn and came up empty. SAPELLO LARUE broke out, raced mid pack and had nothing left for the drive. EL GRAN COGNAC broke awkwardly, moved up to vie to the upper stretch and gave way. TICTAC DOUGH was hustled along to vie early and stopped.
