FUZZY LOVIN moved to the inside nearing the turn, angled outside OVER THE RIVER leaving the turn, was carried out to path six into the stretch, slowly lugged in as he dueled through the lane, brushed with the latter deep stretch and edged ahead in time. OVER THE RIVER vied for the lead just off the rail, drifted out to path five entering the stretch, gradually lugged in as he battle to hold onto the advantage, was brushed in the waning yards and had to settle for second best. GABE'S GOLD advanced from inside on the bend, floated out some into the lane, threatened with a furlong to go, finished evenly instead but was easily best of the rest. AGGIE COLEMINER prominent between rivals, failed to keep up on the turn, swung out widest for the drive and had no late bid. MIDNIGHTWITHDRAWAL in tight briefly at the start, was a contender toward the outside on the backstretch but faded between rivals on the bend. TRICKY BATTLE contested the pace between horses, began to fade three wide leaving the turn, lost ground fanning to path seven into the stretch and continued to fade. SLEWPERMAN was a factor from outside early but gave way on the bend. RAGGED DESCENT showed little in a ground-saving trip.
