Footnotes

JAC CADILLAC rated from outside, was just off the rail on the bend, swung to path three for the drive, made a strong move between rivals under a drive and got up in time. WHAT'S THE RUMPUS settled in midpack, gradually angled out through the turn, came five wide into the stretch, gained the advantage inside the final furlong, slowly lugged in deep stretch and was outfinished. FIRST CLASSNTHESKY settled between horses, was also just off the inside on the bend, fanned out four wide entering the lane, lost considerable ground angling out widest upper stretch, closed well but came up short. WHOA SAILOR sprinted clear, showed the way just off the inside through the turn then gradually wore down for the drive. NATHAN'S SPECIAL a bit erratic as he moved outside the pacesetter early on, was in paths three then four taking the bend, still threatened with a furlong left but finished evenly. TEHUANTEPECER far back from outside, moved to the inside on the turn, angled back to the outside midstretch and lacked a significant response. KELA DAWN saved ground and failed to menace.
