Footnotes

LUCKY SEARCH steadied and checked repeatedly while boxed in behind the leaders on the backstretch, got through three wide midway on the turn, moved clear upper stretch, weaved slightly as he began to wear down inside the final furlong but held on under steady urging. MAXIMUM TWIST moved to the outside early on, lost considerable ground five then six wide taking the bend, closed well in the stretch but came up short. AIRWAR in the second flight from outside, was four wide taking the turn and found best stride too late deep stretch. SNEAK AND PEAK shared the lead from outside, was two wide on the turn, had every chance through the lane but lacked the extra needed. HI HENNESSY displayed early speed just off or along the rail but weakened for the drive. STORMY PAL was soon far back and well off the rail, moved to the inside entering the turn, gradually angled out to gain a clear path through the lane and was closing the gap. SUNLAND SOUVENIR dwelt then made a small leap from the gate, spotting the field several lengths, progressed from inside but wore down in the lane. RIVER JONES an early factor between horses, faded four wide on the bend.
