Footnotes

HEZA TRICK shared the early lead from inside, moved clear on the turn, began to lengthen command under urging in the stretch, began to wear down the final sixteenth but dug in to hold off HEZA ALLIGATOR under a drive in the waning yards. HEZA ALLIGATOR unhurried and taken inside early on, picked up his pace along the rail on the bend, lost ground altering out six wide at the top of the lane, lugged in some briefly upper stretch, was corrected, closed well but came up short. ROMANINTHESTORM forwardly placed inside, came off the rail some for a clear path entering the stretch, fought for second as he closed the gap on the leader, did not have enough late but gained third. MURDEROUS vied for the lead from outside, could not stay with HEZA TRICK while three wide on the bend, floated out some entering the lane, battled to keep second as he made up ground on the leader inside the final furlong but also did not have enough left. GOLDEN M P gradually angled in on the backstretch to be just off the rail on the bend, drifted out to the middle of the track entering the stretch and could only make up minor ground the last sixteenth. SIMPLE DEAL dueled for the lead from between rivals, began to fade two wide on the turn, floated out to path five entering the lane, angled in some when crowded briefly upper stretch and continued to give way.
