Footnotes

YVETT'S MAAR bumped twice and pinched briefly at the break, was rated off the early speed, commenced his bid from path four on the bend, was carried out six wide for the stretch run, took over nearing the furlong marker and was driven clear inside the last eighth. WORLD GENIUS bumped with YVETT'S MAAR just after the break, was settled outside, lost ground widest through the bend, drifted out briefly upper stretch, held a straight path the last furlong and caught EASTERN GOLD for second. EASTERN GOLD contested the pace from inside, was just off the rail on the turn, floated out to path four entering the lane, could not hold back YVETT'S MAAR, lugged in some and slowly yielded inside the final sixteenth. RIVER JONES bumped with YVETT'S MAAR at the start, was settled, three to five wide taking the bend and found best stride too late in the stretch. ROLLINROLLINNDOUGH vied for the lead just outside EASTERN GOLD, was carried out by that one into the stretch and also gradually lugged in as she wore down. RAMOUR soon trailed, saved ground and showed little.
