ONEAL HADIF shared the lead from between horses, moved ahead when allowed and angled in entering the turn, responded to mild urging in the lane then continued to widened command while ridden out. JOLIVA DEVINE broke alertly, contested the pace briefly between rivals, could not stay with ONEAL HADIF while in path four on the turn, angled inside MASTERS CROWNJEWEL entering the stretch, lodged her bid and caught the latter for second. MASTERS CROWNJEWEL also dueled for the early lead from inside, was checked when her path was compromised into the bend, altered out some, came into the lane from path four and did not have enough left the last eighth. KERCHINK KERCHINK stumbled at the start, was settled, saved ground through the turn and found best stride too late. CLASS 'N SASSY hesitated at the start, had no speed just off the inside, came into the stretch behind JOLIVA DEVINE, angled outside that one midstretch and was closing the gap. THIRST FOR DIXIE was prominent from outside on the backstretch, lost considerable ground widest through the turn but showed a willingness to run the last eighth. MID SUMMER'S HOPE broke somewhat slowly and inward, was then steadied behind traffic, angled in after that, saved ground taking the turn then made up ground the final furlong. CYNTHIA'S MISSILE raced in contention five wide for more than three furlongs then began to flatten.
