FAIR MARKET VALUE chased the pace going three wide, made a bid but hung a little mid stretch then offered a late surge to get up at the wire. LUNCH BOX stalked the pace, then rallied, two wide and was outfinished at the wire, just missing the win. CANTALLBECHIEFS trailed the field early, making a steady gain throughout, angled out down the lane going four wide and got up for show. CALL TRANSFER was void of early foot, two wide with a mild rally. BANKER'S WAY was near the back on the inside, angled out mid stretch and offered a mild bid. COBRAMATIC was the early leader and faded at the eighth pole.
